If you see a + next to Resources, click on it to open the category

Options for the LILT Information Literacy Resource:

- **Tutorials (or The LILT)** are found by clicking on the word **Tutorials**. From the list that appears you can select which tutorial you want to view. Each tutorial is divided into several parts. You should view the parts in order, but you may view each part at a different sitting, so you can take a break if needed.

If you are on campus, some of the tutorials (Unit 1 and Unit 2) may be viewed better using the "on campus" version. If you are working off-campus, you should use the other version displayed.

- **Quizzes** are found by clicking on the word **Quizzes**. From the list of available quizzes, select the one that corresponds to a tutorial you have completed. Please do not take a quiz if you have not viewed the tutorial--that would be like asking you to take a test on material that wasn't taught!

A quiz may be restricted to students. You may be asked for a password, need to be enrolled in a specific credit course or blocked if a quizzing deadline set by your credit course professor has passed. If you need to take a quiz and are blocked, please contact Debra Rollins (in the library, ext 6443, or email drollins@lsua.edu) for more information.

- **Surveys** are found by clicking on the word **Surveys**. From the list of surveys available, select the one that corresponds to the course for which you were asked to participate.
